WHO BEING DULY SWORN UPON OATH DECLARES AS FOLLOWS:

Harvey Flenoigh and I started living together in about 1891 at Versailles, Kentucky. Up to the time of his enlistment in the Spanish American War we were the parents of two children, Cythia and Lucile. Up to the time of his death we had three more children, Robert, Elnora and Dorthy. Elnora and Dorthy were born in Indiana, the others were born in Kentucky. Cynthia, Lucile and Dorthy are alive, the other children being dead.

Never in our married life did we own any realestate and there was never a deed (joint or otherwise) conveying any property. We did have at one time a chattel loan on our household goods and this was signed by us as husband and wife. That is the only money we ever borrowed. This loan was in force at the time of my husbands death in 1910 and was with the Security Mortgage and Loan Company of Indianapolis. I am advised that records with this company are only kept for two years. I have no paper from them as all of my personal belongings were lost at the time of the flood here in 1913.

My husband carried insurance with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company and at the time of his death this was paid to me. We never joined church together but we did attend church. We attended the Campbell Chapel Methodist Church in Indianapolis.

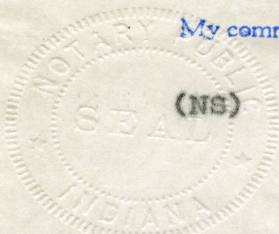
