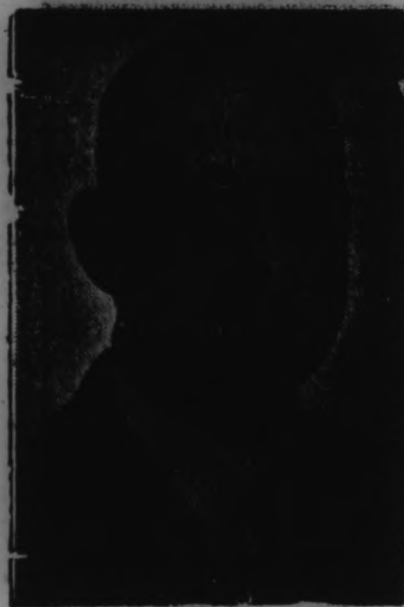

Woman's Day at Caldwell Chapel Sunday, Two Guest Speakers For the Occasion

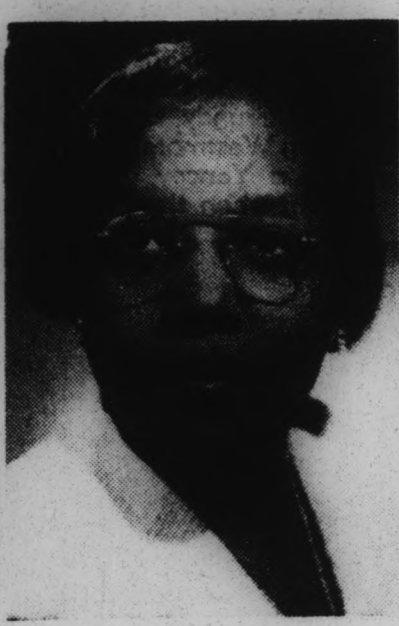
