

100. What is JACOBS "ungodliness"? (Rom. 11:25, 26). A. They shirk prophecy and cleave to words of man (Num. 23:19, Jer. 17:5-, Rom. 3:5-8, Rev. 2:1, 2). Many prophets were killed by them (Mat. 22:31). These blacks of JACOB must cease shirking prophecy (old testament-2 Cor. 3:14) and try learning it. Proof of GODS anger against JACOB for shirking HIS words to the prophets was revealed in 1969-70, their cry was published throughout many nations: "BLACK MAN CRY, WHO AM 1?". Their beginning, ancient history, eternal positions and identity is all recorded in prophecy. Learning GODS work in prophecy is the only way black Jews of JACOB may "escape" mans leasing and return to GOD in TRUTH (Isa. 10:20, 21, John 9:32, Psm 1:1-6). 
