Robert Williams was what would be a veterinarian now he cared for the animals if a baby was expected at night he slept in the barn. Harriet was small in stature not much over 4ft tall she didn't sell too well on the block but she was an excellent cook and housekeeper and for that reason she was sold along with Robert otherwise they would have been separated. They belonged to the Carter family in Virginia but were sold to the Williams in Tennessee. Culpepper sent William C. Cole Maps and Yearbooks of Culpepper. Kizzie has them in St. Louis.
