

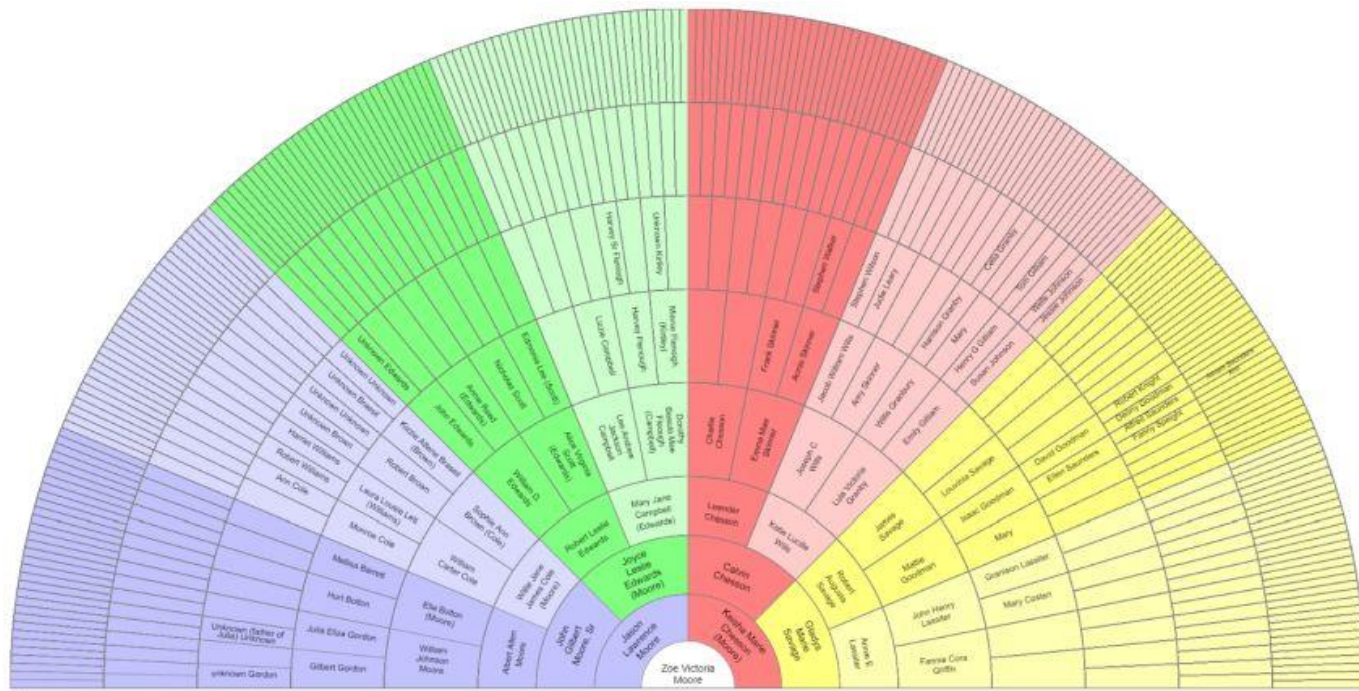

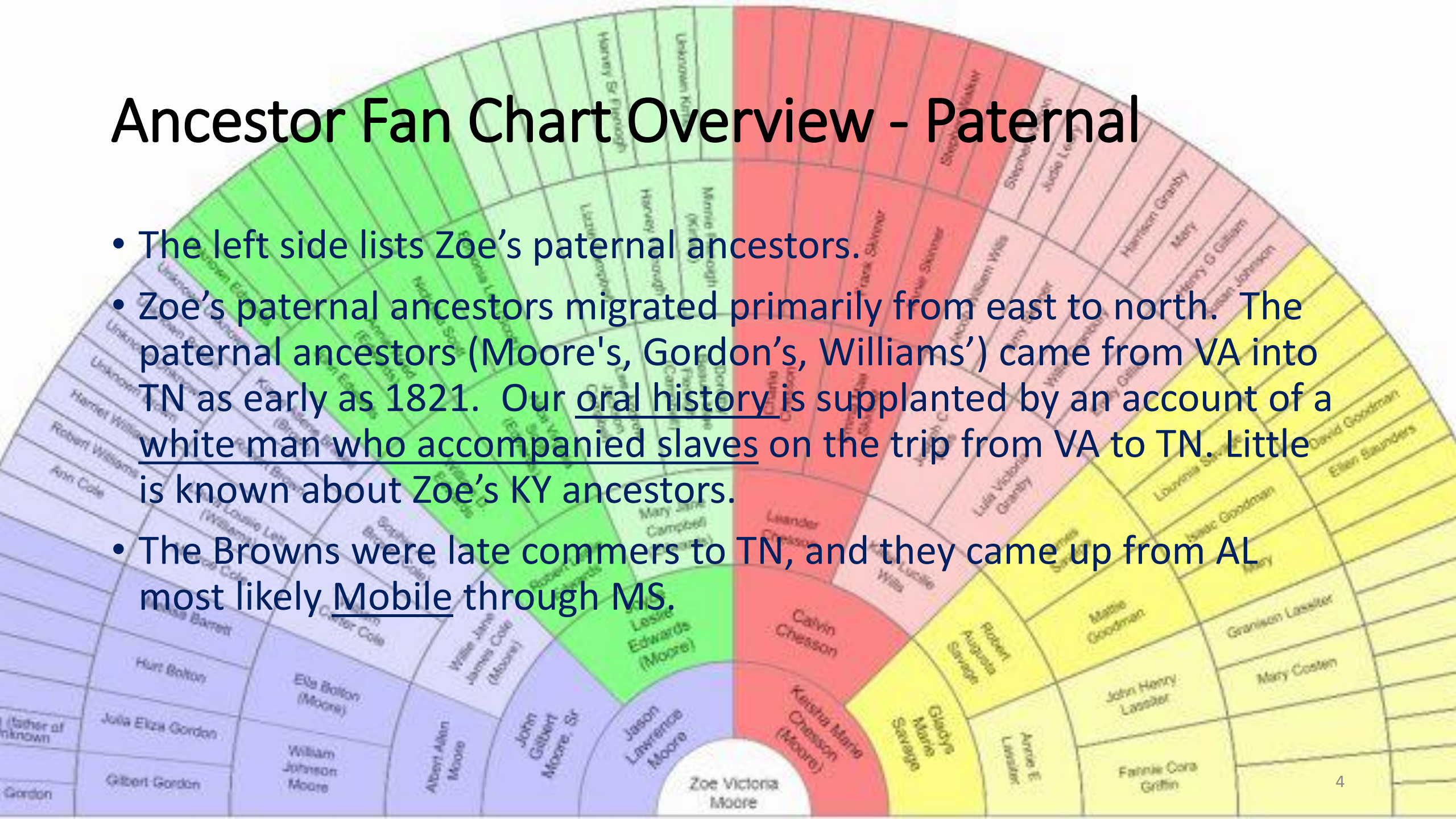


Family tree information of significant life events have been placed on an interactive map

- About the map. In some cases, all that is known is what the dependent indicated on a census, “Father was born in Alabama”. In other cases we know quite a bit.
- Significance may not be placed on how long the ancestor was in a place. [Harvey Flenough](#) was only in [Utah for six months](#).
- The earliest timepoint is [1773](#), so many of the changes in location were of enslaved persons. Only two names are recorded for the ninth generation; imagine the names missing since 1619.

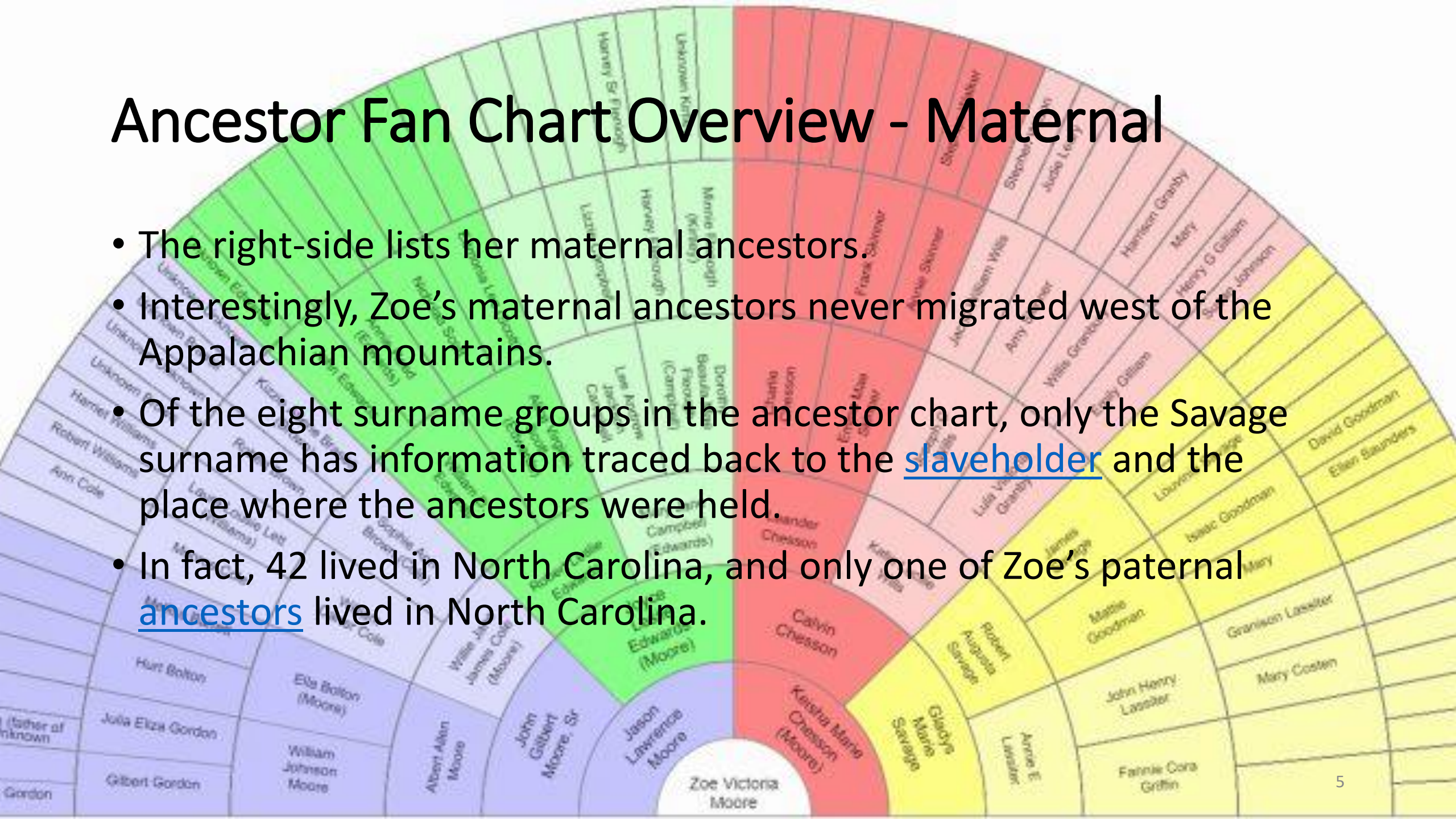
Ancestor Fan Chart Overview - Paternal

- The left side lists Zoe's paternal ancestors.
- Zoe's paternal ancestors migrated primarily from east to north. The paternal ancestors (Moore's, Gordon's, Williams') came from VA into TN as early as 1821. Our oral history is supplanted by an account of a white man who accompanied slaves on the trip from VA to TN. Little is known about Zoe's KY ancestors.
- The Browns were late commers to TN, and they came up from AL most likely Mobile through MS.



Ancestor Fan Chart Overview - Maternal

- The right-side lists her maternal ancestors.
- Interestingly, Zoe's maternal ancestors never migrated west of the Appalachian mountains.
- Of the eight surname groups in the ancestor chart, only the Savage surname has information traced back to the [slaveholder](#) and the place where the ancestors were held.
- In fact, 42 lived in North Carolina, and only one of Zoe's paternal [ancestors](#) lived in North Carolina.

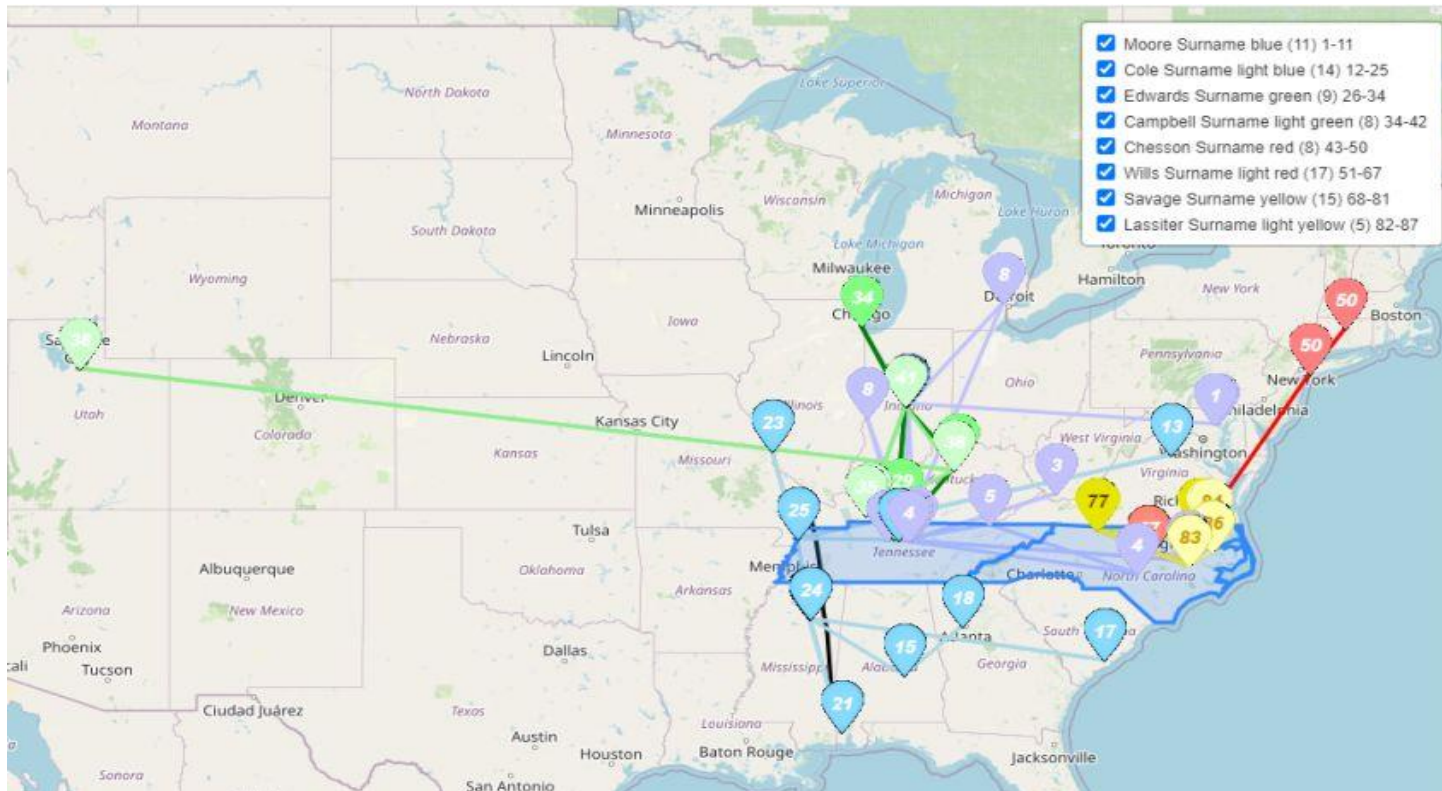
