O blessed Savior count on me.



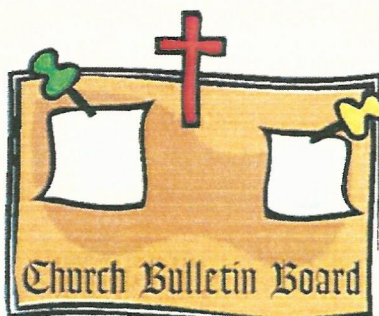
Announcements

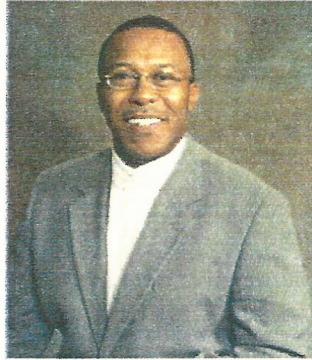

In 1985 he earned his B.A. in Classical Languages (Hebrew, Greek, & Latin) and Theology from Indiana Christian University Indianapolis.

He also holds two degrees from Christian Theological Seminary—a Master of Divinity 1990 and a Doctor of Ministry 1999.

Since 1992 Dr. Phillip Shobe has served as the Pastor of the St. John's Baptist Church of Indianapolis.
