receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
you, G. W. Floyd and wife J. A. Floyd,
have this day bargained, sold and
do by these presents transfer and convey

unto R. E. Fowler, L. M. Philbrick, and J. S. Duggan, Trustees of the Rossow Cemetery
the following strip of land on the south, and adjoining said cemetery;
beginning at the NW corner of said cemetery, running thence south 70 links to
a stake, thence east 20 poles to a stake, thence north 20 links to the south
line of said cemetery, thence west 20 poles to the beginning containing one
tenth of one acre more or less,

To have and to hold the same to said trustees and their successors
or assigns, you and yours our heirs and assigns to warrant
and defend the title to said above described land to the said trustees
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever,
witness our hands, March 25th 1903,

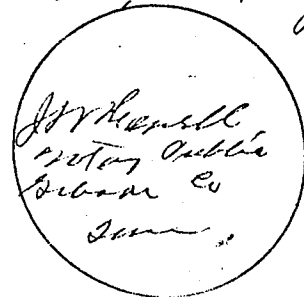

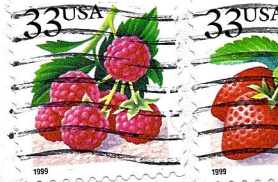
