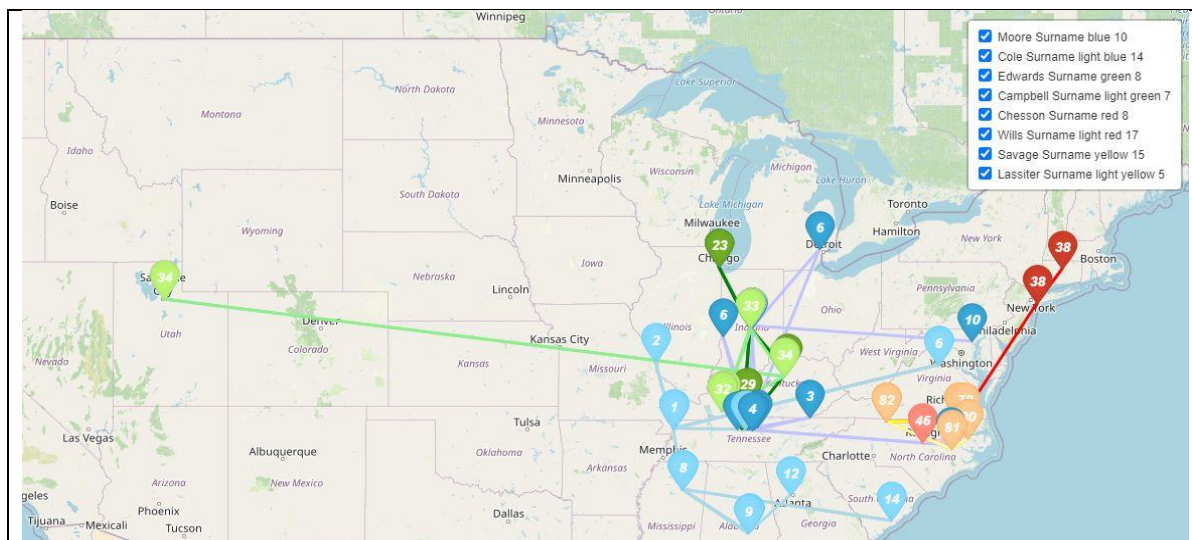

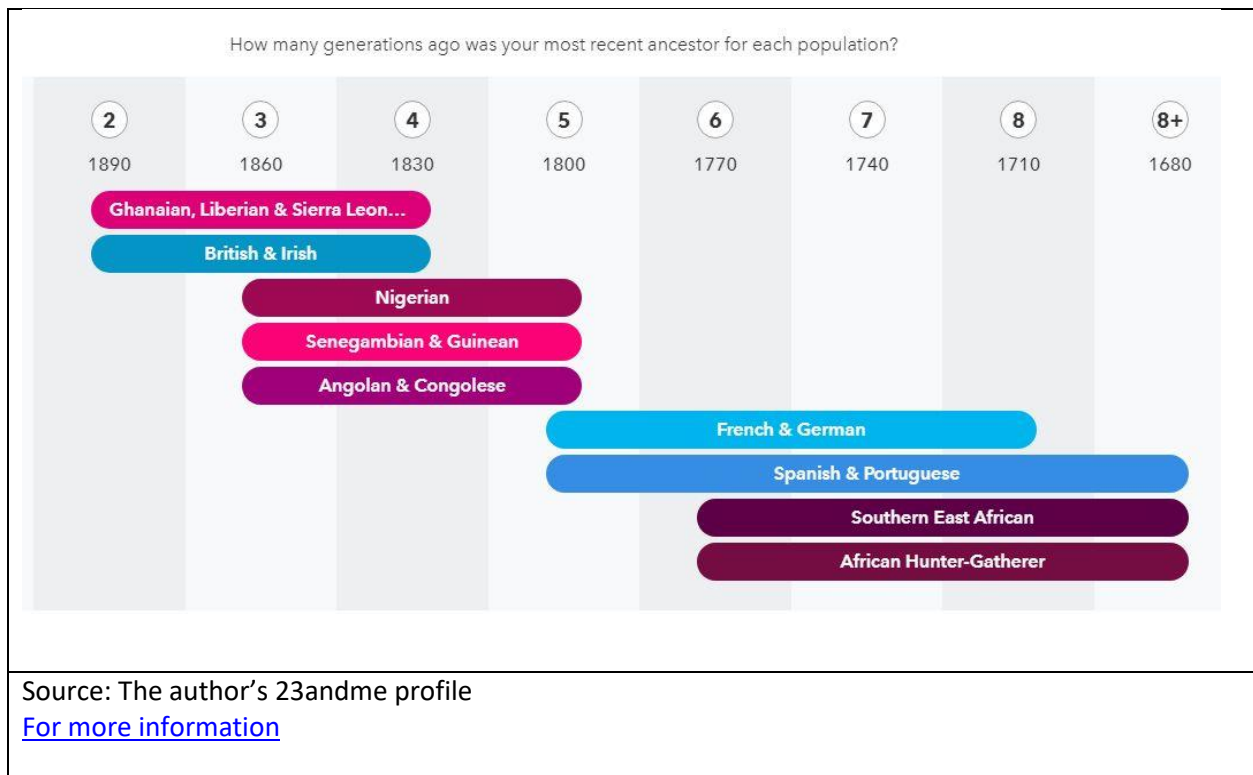

Author's Note

At the front of this book is a map with the significant locations where Zoe's eighty-four direct ancestors lived pursuing the elusive American Dream. In the surname group portion of the book each of the direct ancestors will be presented in varying detail. In each of the eight surname groups the so-called End of the Line ancestor section will include a listing of all their known relatives, who aren't included in the map.

The map reveals the general migration pattern of our known ancestors; arrived on the east coast of America, and taken either west, or drawn north over time. My goal is to pass on information I've become aware of and point out questions I have about of ancestors. In the "Age of John" section, I hope to let you and your descendants know about me in my own words and images. The first part of this trilogy is a make-believe happenstance near the one hundredth anniversary of my birth. In summary this project hopes to provide the past, present, and future of the Moore surname that we are part of.

As I write this book in 2020 I have such limited information on our ancestors, and hope that previously lost information can be recovered, and information from my current time can be preserved. All things must have a beginning, middle, and an end (future). Let me present what I know about the beginning:

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Introduction

On November 6, 2019 Joyce and I attended a presentation related to the 1619 Project, on the IUPUI campus. The group in attendance was primarily college students and staff, with a few ASALH members. Our neighbor Anthony Artis and his drum troupe provided the opening for the presentation. The focus of the presentation was the group reading and discussion of the Our democracy's founding ideals were false when they were written. Black Americans have fought to make them true. By Nikole Hannah-Jones (<https://nikolehannahjones.com/>). The primary event was Nikole Hannah-Jones is an award-winning investigative reporter covering racial injustice for The New York Times Magazine. A 2016 Peabody Award winner for her series on school segregation for "This American Life" and 2017 MacArthur Fellow, Hannah-Jones was most recently the lead journalist for the 1619 Project. "Join us—Civic Saturday style—as we use history, poetry, and music to anchor a conversation about why it is time to revolutionize the way we talk about our past. About how it is a moral imperative we re-frame conversations on history, society, and race in order to address systemic injustices." America's traditional origin stories don't work for everyone and now is the time to wrestle with the meaning of who we are and who we want to be in order to bring America closer to its promises. We did not attend the primary event, but we participated in the November 6th event. Both Joyce and I participate in the group reading and asked and answered questions of those in attendance; arguable Joyce and I were the oldest in attendance (due to parking and not sure of the location were not on time to be acknowledged at the opening). My reflection on the 1619 Project is that most of the material presented I was aware of in the 1960's but didn't KNOW for sure if these things were true because I didn't hear these things through "regular" channels; most of what is present in the 1619 project came to many negroes came through back channels - at home, at the front porch, at the barbershop, on the corner, etc. A young man asked an open question about stereotypes be perpetrated and how we can possibly catch up to white Americans. The founder of Martin University was mentioned, I offered the impact of seeing a Black priest in the late 1960's as being monumental. The effect of attending the event was to think about my direct ancestors who lived during the past 400 years. The purpose of this document is to record my thoughts on my life as I don't know much about the life and times of my ancestors "in their own words" so my descendants may be able to hear about my life and times in my own words. A picture is worth a thousand words, so I have endeavored to include a thousand pictures to help tell our story.

The goal of this book is to give our descendants a better idea of what our lives were like in our own words and view not that of historians.

I started in family history out of curiosity about where are my relatives on my father's side are and who are they. It was during the time when my Mom came to live with us, that we had the time to connect. I used a public domain program downloaded from a bulletin board on a Kaypro computer to create my first family tree that was assembled into a three by five-foot sheet that I mailed to my known cousins. This was in the 1980's, so in the 2020's most readers will need to Google most words in the preceding sentence. As Black Americans continue on their genealogy quest we are encouraged "tell our story".

In 2009 I began to record and share our family history via an internet site, Edwards-Moore-family.net, and joined a genealogy group. Since 2009, I have presented various topics at genealogy groups, and displayed my research at conferences. In the ensuing years, I've been told I need to write a book. The impetus for me writing the book is the curiosity my descendants will have about my "life and times", I felt while reading the 1619 Project reported by the New York Times newspaper. Simply put the goal of this book is to provide my descendants with insight into my life and times. The focus of this book is my three grandchildren, they are entrusted with telling the story in the turning of the next century (2101). Enjoy peeking into how your ancestors navigated and triumphed in their history.

In genealogy we record residences and occupations, it's difficult to delve deeper into the "times" in a traditional genealogy history book, so please read my other book that goes beyond what is now considered genealogy. Recently I read an account of manuscripts

being preserved in Timbuktu detailing the life and times of your ancient ancestors, in time maybe these writing will be transcribed for your consumption. Thanks to DNA advances we know our ancestors were there! One final note, this is a surname book, meaning its purpose is to tell the story of the Moore surname. The Moore-edwards-family.net website contains information on ALL know relatives of our grandchildren, over one thousand. All known direct ancestors of my grandchildren are the focus, with additional focus given to the surname Moore and Gordon.

Once in my 60's I thought to ask my sister what my father voice sounded like, I was six when he died, she was eighteen; she said it was like his grandson Albert Jr voice. A picture is worth a thousand words, so be advised that this book has almost a thousand pictures. This book is an extract of our family website that contains pictures, stories, audio and video records of how we lived. This book is an attempt to chronical the life and times of the Edwards-Moore family at the end of the second millennial and the first century of beginning of the third millennial. Out of over a thousand individuals recorded on our family website only less than one hundred of Zoe's ancestors have been chosen to be featured in this book, eighty-two direct ancestors and the authors immediate family and a few other ancestors who have been researched.

A complete index of all references to online material is included in the endnotes, as the true purpose of this book is to document nature and scope of material on the family website. A companion book for John Gilbert Moore, III and Ayani Jizelle Moore is available to provide additional family information.

My initial plan for the book was to have three sections,

1. A fictional representation of what was going on in Zoe's life on the one hundredth anniversary of my birth 2/4/2048.
2. A memoir of my life, things that might not make the history books.
3. A representation of our family history recorded on our family website. In 2020 it's nearly impossible to get a website copywrite, yet fairly easy to copywrite a book

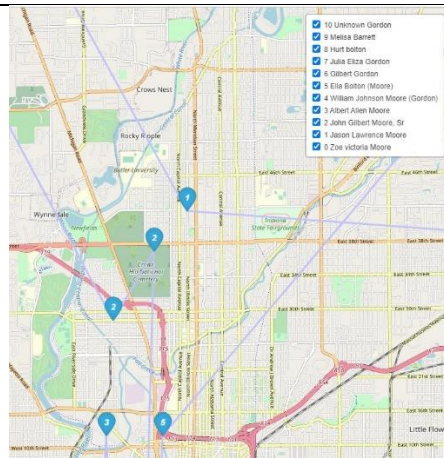

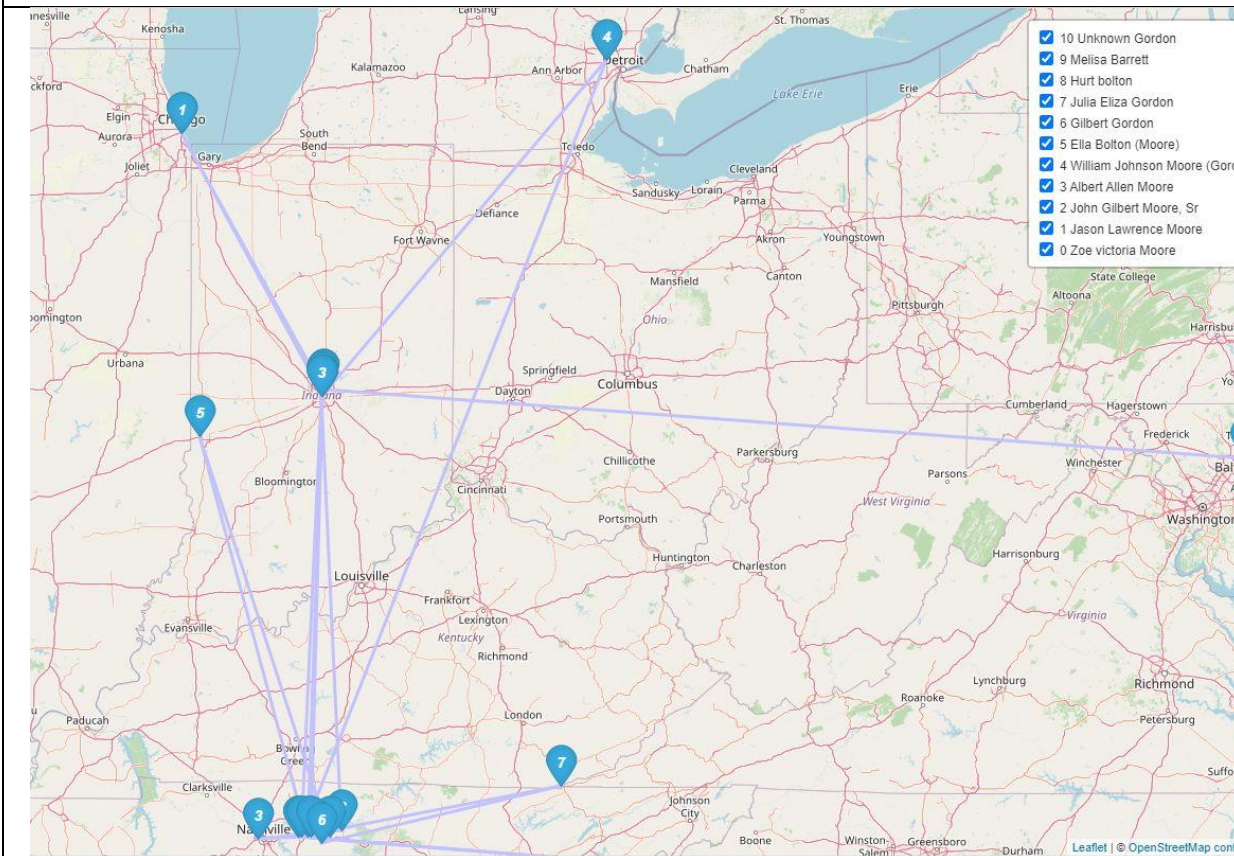


I was in my 60's before I know my paternal grandparents lived in Indianapolis.

The location of where the the ten Moore direct ancestors of Zoe are shown below. The earlist Moore ancestor Unknown Gordon was born in the 1830's. The migration pattern was generally form north to west. The migration over the Apachia Mountains in the the 1830s is [well documented](#). In addition to the work done by Edward Ball, my mother recounted stores she was told of how our family got from Virginia to western Tennessee. Her written text of how the Cole family crossed the mountains is included in the Cole surname section of the book. The chapter on William Johnson Moore details how we have the surname of Moore. The second set of migration for the Moore surname occurred about a hundred years later when many moved from middle Tennessee to central Indiana. Zoe has eight surname groups documented in this book, the Moore Surname Group is detailed as follows.....
