served as secretary, assis-

and the Minister's Wives Al-  
liance.

She served as secretary and  
assistant secretary in the A-  
postolic Bible Student's As-  
sociation, and worked in her  
home church, Grace, as a  
Sunday School teacher and a  
member of the choir.

A native of this city, Mrs.  
Golder travelled extensively.  
She and a dear friend, Mrs.  
Oretta White of Logansport,  
had made two trips to the Ba-  
hamas, Puerto Rico, Haiti and  
the East Indies.

She had also visited the Ho-  
ly Land, making stops in  
Rome, Paris, London, New  
York and Greece. In addition,  
she travelled with her hus-  
band who has worked over a  
long period of years in the  
Pentecostal Assemblies of the  
World.

As years passed, the young  
people of the church affectio-  
nately called her "Nanny."
