Today, marks a historic occasion to which we are most reverent. The history of our church is but only tawlwe years of age but its accomplisionents are noteworthy. This church always will be a beacon-light to those out in the world to see.

Let us look backwards for just a moment to our first humble beginning as an organized mission at 2411 Schofield dvenue on October the 6th, 1957. With five chartered members, Pro. Matthew Groun, Sis. Essie Brown and Sis. Hury Milliams who are now deceased, and two others, Sis. Mattic Brown and Sis. Nuth Marrell. Through much prayer and faith in God's help we neved to a rented store front at 815 East 15th Street on November the 9th,1957 For our church services.

Ister on December the bth, 1957 after much prayer and deliberation we,the members, of Grace Wenorial Reptist Ourch was recognized as a church. It was an uranimous second that Rev. James H. Brown would be our pastor with great joy.

with four churches represented of which two pastors are now deceased, the Rev. D. B. Judley of Galilee Raptist Courch and Rev.R.7 Mumford, pastor of Zion Hope, and two others, lattle bethel, The Serv. Ollie Revers, and his Associate minister, Rev. Stary Shields, and the Rev. B.7. Almon, pastor of New Haptist.

Our first Sunday School Class was held on December 15th, 1957, We then started making provisions on our Building Fund Program on April the 27th, 1958. The Lord continued to blass⁴Hat our attendance increased so that we moved to our first building at 21t5 Saltimore Avenue in September of 1961 at a total cost of 316,000. In kovember of 1967 with the growth and progress of our city, we were demanded to vacate our building. At that time on our membership roll we had 50 Active Adults, 30 children and 3 Associate ministers.

After such asditation on there our services would be held a very gracious pastor, the Bev. indrew J. Brown of St.John Missionary Paptist Church offered us the facilities of a store front at 17th and Nartindale Streets until the completion of our church, we are truly thankful to God and to those wonderful people sho made this place possible for our vorship services. Our membership at this location was 50 4dults, 10 children for baptiss, 3 Mults for baptiss, 3 reinstated and 35 children and our Hit Associates tributar.

On October 1st, 1967, which was the first Sunday in the south, we had our Ground-Freaking Sarviers for our new edifice located at 3002 North dams Streat. The glorious day arrived, karch the 2/41,1969 dhen our pater, and members marched into our house for the Lord at a total cost of 56,000. The present membership is 50 daults, by reinstated, 35 cardidates for baptism, 2 Adults baptized and h§ children

This now brings us up to the present, the Lord is continuing to bring workers. With our more than capable pastor. Rev. James M. Brown, as our Leader.
