Hereby I'd like to give credit to MyBusiness website plan (not the business hosting package). The advantage of the website plan as opposed to the Business hosting package is the website plan allowed us to quickly create a fully functional website without any programming. When we were working towards a mid to near launch date this was a compelling offer for us because, maintaining the functionality of the site - our pages will need to be redesigned as an additional small hosting package was needed to be purchased (at \$50 per month) and some additional software purchased (\$50). Several email addresses have been created (in the 1000's) however, all with the same password as the site password: CHURCH2010. A general comment on our church's email com [www.CHURCH.org] is employed in the footer banner that is embedded in the site content page.

The 1001 business website plan does not have the following features: data storage location, MySQL database access, PHP scripting language. Two of the KNF site pages make use of features not included in the 1001 MyBusiness website plan, they are the 'travel' and the 'Sabbath Minutes' from the 'Book of the Week' page. All web servers for our site are stored in the 'central' rack location. The 'travel' page is hosted by someone named family.com [http://www.family.com/]. The 'Sabbath Minutes' page is hosted by someone named family.com [http://www.family.com/]. The software that drives the 'travel' page is open source software developed at the University of British Columbia [http://www.sarng.com/~sars/sb/external.html]. This software needs to be on a server with access to the PHP scripting language and the ability to create and store files. My ability to modify the appearance of the 'travel' site in the 'travel' page is a good example. I do not have the book knowledge to modify anything else. The 'Sabbath Minutes' from the 'Book of the Week' page employs software package called MarkForm from Appleton Software [http://www.apple.com/]. MarkForm and other SQL stuff needs to be installed on a server that has access to MySQL database and the PHP scripting language. I use MarkForm because it quickly allows us to embed a data entry form into the site with the ability to ftp files to it rather than have people try to search for files in email's link form. My MarkForm is a simple system, so if KNF has the password they have the password in my personal files as well. After the 1001s the website handled the need for this page should go away.

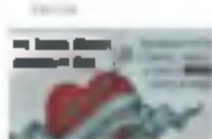

Rev. Clarence C. Moore was born November 28, 1955 in Western Salem, North Carolina to Clarence and Lea Hilda Hoyle Moore. He is the eldest of four children.

He attended the public schools of Winston-Salem. Upon graduation he enrolled at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro where he received a Bachelor of Science in Finance Administration in May 1978. While at the University, Rev. Moore received national awards and recognition. He was voted Outstanding Student by the graduating class of 1978 chosen by the Church for the distinction to serve on the Home Care Commission and Admissions Council.

Rev. Moore began work as his personal pastor at an early age and was baptised in the Canaan Missionary Baptist Church, Western Salem, North Carolina. He served as greeters of the youth choir and guitar player in other youth activities.
