CONCLUSION

Searching for Jerry Moore's origin yielded his family's emancipation record and biographical information about him and his descendants. His children and grandchildren became part of a thriving African American community in what would become Pittsburgh's North Side, an area with a deep middle class and complex social life. Military pension files, newspapers, probate files, and other sources proved family relationships and wove names and dates into a family narrative.
